### Objectives:

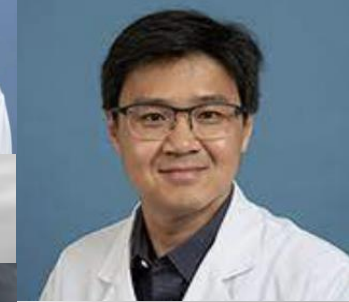
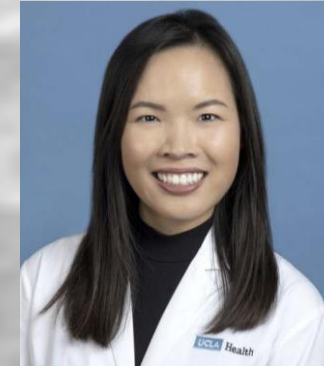
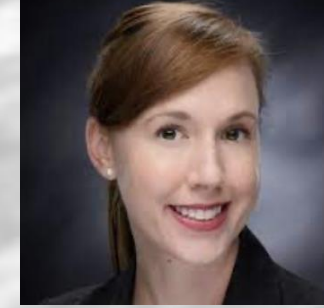
